Hey, everybody!

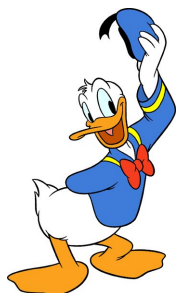

## Doughnuts, Doughnuts, and More Doughnuts

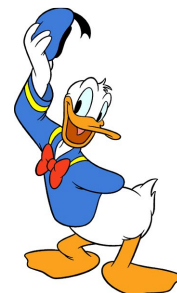
